| n her intimate narrative paintings, Seattle-based artist Kelly Bjork depicts candid moments between friends and lovers within tidy, domestic settings. Painted on paper with gouache and pencil, expressive figuration, patterning, and gratifying hues dominate Bjork's work, confronting the viewer with challenging and amusing imagery. The artist's pleasure-focused motifs invite viewers to enter a world where conflicts and tensions are simply absent. In their place, figures practice self-care (Cultivating Space, 2019), indulge in leisure (The Oracle, The Witches, Us, 2019), and channel deep intimacy (Anima Rising, 2019).

Small in scale, Bjork's compositions present rich visual complexity. The artist renders her scenes in precise detail, with studious attention to textures and patterns on walls, furnishings, and surfaces. Hanging tapestries, throw pillows, bed linens, bath towels,

electrical outlets, rugs, artwork, and decorated herself in a bathroom mirror, and a naked man lying vases are executed with meticulous care. Further, supine on a neatly made bed. Bjork's vignettes of Bjork creates continuity between her paintings intimacy, comfort, and simplicity within everyday with recurring items—a lampshade from her Joshua settings offer viewers a welcome respite from the Tree series, an expressive abstract painting, a hand- often not-so-blissful realities of our world. Her stitched quilt, and a pink electric gemstone light, to paintings are easy to fall into, and once immersed, we name a few. The particularity of these objects signals find ourselves wishing to be guests in Bjork's home. that they are not generic, but exist in a particular location and bear special significance to the artist.

The frank clarity of Bjork's compositions coupled with the tenderness of her subjects evoke the intimacy of snapshots. Her paintings feature a cast of characters, including representations of the artist herself. Many of the figures who inhabit her scenes are shown nude or caught unawares, comfortably coexisting with one another. Her visual memoirs include a portrait of a friend napping, a glimpse of
